Complementary and Alternative Medicine (CAM)

In Europe one in four citizens use complementary and alternative medicine as an integral part of their healthcare. Yet the availability of products used in Complementary and Alternative Medicine (CAM), including homeopathic, anthroposophic and herbal medicinal products, is increasingly being reduced by unnecessarily onerous and costly requirements and restrictions resulting from Member States' implementation of the EU directives that regulate them.

This trend threatens to thwart the growing demand of European citizens for more natural, health enhancing, low-risk medicinal products as well as the ability of doctors and practitioners to practise CAM effectively. **Urgent discussions are needed to explore avenues for developing a more appropriate legal framework that allows the continuing viability of these products.**

The meeting will offer the opportunity to enter into active dialogue with relevant policy makers and stakeholders and for the MEP Interest Group to make an informed decision in order to take a proactive stance on a subject that is highly relevant for large numbers of EU citizens.
